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Newly Restored Tax Collector's Office Located at West Pasco Government Center Set to Reopen Next Week

The **Pasco County Tax Collector's Office** located at the West Pasco Government Center (8731 Citizens Drive, New Port Richey) will be fully reopening on Monday, July 20, 2026, at 8:30 AM. All the services that have been on hold and unavailable during the ongoing renovation—including **driver license** services—will once again be available to customers upon reopening.

The newly renovated office will now be able to serve customers at a greater capacity, as the previous 13 front-counter stations have now been increased to 22. In addition to that, we were able to expand the space in our waiting lobby, which should allow for a more comfortable experience for our customers.
